

## PE and Sport Premium Spend 2022/23

The PE and Sport Premium is designed to help primary schools improve the quality of their PE lessons and sporting activities offered to each of their pupils. In 2022-23 we received a grant of **£18,780**.

For the fourth consecutive year, the school have been successful in achieving the Gold Award for the School Games Mark.

Our expenditure for the school year was £18,874.
